

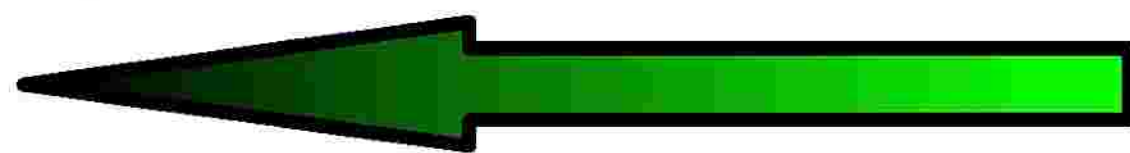
RED SEA MAX MEDIA BASKET

INSTRUCTIONS AND TROUBLESHOOTING

Thank you for your purchase of the RSM3V20. This product is intended to work in the Red Sea Max 130 and new 130D. It will organize and increase the filtration in your aquarium. Please read these instructions before installation for helpful tips and proper use.

- Unpack and rinse your new rack in fresh water.
- Prep your tank by removing the stock protein skimmer. It is a good idea and time to clean the rear chamber if your tank is older and has detritus build up.
- If you have purchased the Tunze 9002 or other skimmer prepare how you are going to mount the equipment. Further instruction on mounting the 9002 can be found later in the directions.
- Prepare your media. Rinse any chemical media bags before installing.
- The proper arrangement for media in the basket is filter floss on top. The lower two shelves can be used for chemical media or even macro algae. inTank recommends running purigen on the second shelf and Chemi Pure Elite on the third.
- Install the media rack under the intake grate which is on the right side of the aquarium if looking at the tank. The rack can only go in **ONE** way. The inTank logo sticker needs to face the electrical panel and the indented brackets face the intake grate.

If you are using Chemi Pure on the third shelf attach the top of the bag to the second shelf with a zip tie. This picks the bottom of the bag off the bottom of the eggcrate. If you do not do this any large media bags may decrease flow in the rack.
